Care and Maintenance Instructions

To obtain the best performance from your new lamp please follow these directions.

Changing the Bulb: To change the light bulbs, please do the following.

1. Unplug the lamp.

2. Remove the shade by simply lifting the shade from the base. Once the shade is off, replace the bulbs. Use only 60 watt maximum Par 16 bulbs. Using a higher wattage bulb will risk burning the polycarbonate shade.

2. Once the bulbs are replaced, place the shade back on. The shade rests just level on the base.

Cleaning: To keep your Cortina Lamp clean, simply wipe with a damp cloth. Do not use cleaning solvents on the polyester fabric shade or polycarbonate housing



Troubleshooting

If The Lamp Does Not Work: Please follow these instructions.

1. Light bulbs may have loosened during shipping. Make sure light bulbs are threaded in properly.
2. If lamp still does not work, unplug the lamp and change out with new light bulbs. Plug the lamp back in and check. If lamp still does not turn on, you may have a faulty lamp base. Please notify Pablo for repair/return instructions.

Shade Seam Becomes Unglued: If the glue seam on the shade becomes unglued due to improper handling, you may use a dab of crazy glue to repair.

Cracked Sockets: If your lamp arrives with a broken socket due to shipping mishandling, contact Pablo for a socket assembly replacement or send base unit only back to Pablo for repair
