

Sail Light

Unique table light whose adjustable sail-like mylar shade mimics the movements of a sailing vessel. Base unit is machined aluminum with a pivoting shade to direct light where needed.

Care and Maintenance Instructions

To obtain the best performance from your new lamp please follow these instructions. The Sail light's tubular glass bulb cover is half frosted and clear. The frosted side is designed to face the rear and the clear side is designed to face the mylar shade. However, this positioning is optional to user discretion.

Changing the Bulb:

1. Unplug the lamp.
2. To replace a burnt out bulb simply lift the glass diffuser up and off then unscrew the bulb. Use only a 60 watt maximum T-10 bulb. Otherwise you risk damaging the lamp.
3. Replace the glass diffuser.

Cleaning: To keep your Sail Light clean, wipe with a clean soft damp cloth.

Troubleshooting

If The Lamp Does Not Work: Please follow these instructions:

1. Light bulb may have loosened during shipping. Remove the glass diffuser. Make sure light bulb is screwed in properly. Check to see if lamp works.
2. If lamp still does not work, unplug the lamp and change out with a new light bulb. Plug the lamp back in and check. If lamp still does not turn on, you may have a faulty lamp base. Please notify Pablo for a repair/return instructions.
